Standards Accountability Assessment

Created and launched by the Standards of Excellence Committee, the Standards Accountability Assessment offers member organizations an opportunity to benchmark their adherence to 100 standards specific to health and human service nonprofit organizations, as reviewed by a nonprofit attorney.

Public Policy Highlights

Public Policy Committee members met with seven county and state elected officials to discuss One Voice’s 2023 Impact of Nonprofits in Austin Report and to advocate for the Central Texas nonprofit sector. One Voice members also served on the Texas Nonprofit Strong Day panel and collectively supported Texas Nonprofit Strong’s 2023 Public Policy Initiatives and Tennessee Nonprofit Network’s call to support the Streamlining Federal Grants Act.



Trainings and Workshops



In 2023, One Voice members had access to trainings centered around equity, mental health, and financial management and investing.

Events

In 2023, membership meetings were held every month, with several held in-person. Member meeting topics addressed overcoming organizational challenges including staffing, funding, post-COVID impacts, preventing burnout, advocacy support groups, and policies impacting the nonprofit sector. One Voice's September member meeting was dedicated to celebrating the 40th Anniversary of One Voice Central Texas at UFCU. One Voice's networking and social events were also hosted in-person at The Brewtorium in June and December.

403(b) Retirement Plan

Investment Committee members oversaw the management of One Voice's 403(b) Retirement Plan. In 2023 there were 14 participating organizations with 1,124 active participants and assets totaling over over \$29.5 million. This is a growth of \$6 million over the past year.

Sustainability



A task force was created in 2023 to prioritize the sustainability of One Voice's funding and operations. One Voice Central Texas received \$75,000 in grant funding from St. David's Foundation, \$13,000 in sponsorship funding from 5 new sponsors, and over \$10,000 of in-kind support and benefits from Atchley and Associates, UFCU, and Consultants for Good. \$9,500 was also raised in collaboration with six other Austin organizations for the Decolonizing Wealth workshop in May.
